1870-1871: 24 Temple Place

1874-1879: Allen & Rowell

1875: Allen & Rowell – 25 Winter Street – partnership with Frank Rowell (1832-1900)

Allen & Rowell specialized in carbon printing - Frank Rowell's specialty. When Rowell died obituaries mentioned his "dry plates." Edward Allen ran the "business affairs" of their partnership.

1889: ditto

Allen was also listed in the mercantile index as a dealer in photographic apparatus. He was listed in Boston until the turn of the century.
