This building was built by Fred Sidney Mayo in 1926 Mayo – Fred Sidney Mayo (1877-1949)

"Fred S. Mayo built his house [at 9 Wesley Avenue] in 1922-23 and his shop in 1926." - "Traditions and Records of Southwest Harbor and Somesville, Mount Desert Island, Maine" by Mrs. Seth S. Thornton, 1938, p. 151.

1922: "Fred Mayo has opened a shop in the store in the Masonic building formerly occupied by J.O. Hancock as a meat market. Mr. Mayo will do cabinet work at which he has been employed for the past few years." - Bar Harbor Times, January 4, 1922, p. 6.

Fred apparently conducted his carpentry business at this location around the time he built his house and before he built his carpentry shop on Wesley Avenue [Church Lane.] The exact location in the Masonic Building is still under investigation.

Hancock - John O. Hancock (1854-1924)

"F.S. Mayo is erecting a new building on Church Lane near his residence. When completed this building will have a fully equipped carpenter shop on second floor, with office, show room and lumber storage on first floor. A full line of finish lumber, flooring, sash, doors, clapboards, shingles, etc.. will be carried in stock." - Bur Harbor Times, September 15, 1926.

F.S. Mayo advertised himself in 1931 as a "Carpenter and Builder Fine Furniture Repairing Woodworker and Cabinet Maker We take the Machine to the Job Electric Floor Finishing" Tel. 9, Wesley Ave., Southwest Harbor.
