The business seems to have begun as a grocery and lunch room. An ad in the 1946 Pemetic High School Yearbook, 'The Pemetic', states "Andy's 'The Little Store, Groceries and lunch, Southwest Harbor, Maine' "

"The Pemetic" ads indicate that the dining room was added by 1950.

Next Andy's became "The Cove of the Four R's", a restaurant owned and operated by: Stephen Chester Robbins (1934-1994).

In 1975, the restaurant was purchased by:
Robert John Del Pappa Jr. (1939-)

Kristin Hutchins worked there as a baker during the summer of 1977.
Hutchins - Kristin Rebecca Hutchins (1959-)

In 1983 the business became "The Head of the Harbor Restaurant." It was owned and run by:
Alan D. Hartling (1948-)
And his brother
Steven Ennis Hartling (1947-2002)
They also opened the restaurant of the same name across the road.
