Arno and Mabelle had seven children. In 1910 they were living at Cranberry and Arno was fishing for a living. He had been doing well enough at his wholesale fish business in the late 1890s to have an elegant invoice made for his "Fresh Fish Market" in Northeast Harbor. The invoice is in the collection of the Great Cranberry Island Historical Society.

Things did not go as smoothly as he had hoped. Arno had mental problems. He was possibly bi-polar, had mood swings, and was "difficult." He took down his stovepipe because there was a bend in his chimney, causing creosore to build up and cause chimney fires and he felt that too much wood was being burned. When he lived at 4,43 Cranberry Road, Map 6 – Lot 4, between 1912 and 1926 he was said to have built a stone wall behind his house to defend himself from the Germans in WWI. Arno was a hoarder. He made his children go out to work and took their pay to invest in
